Confirmation statements

63 Confirmation statements: offences

- (1) The Companies Act 2006 is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 853J (power to amend duties to deliver certain information), in subsection (4)(a)—
 - (a) at the end of sub-paragraph (i) insert “and”;
 - (b) for sub-paragraphs (ii) to (iv) substitute—

“(ii) every officer of the company who is in default;”.
- (3) In section 853L (failure to deliver confirmation statement)—
 - (a) in subsection (1)—
 - (i) at the end of paragraph (a) insert “and”;
 - (ii) for paragraphs (b) to (d) substitute—

“(b) every officer of the company who is in default.”;
 - (b) omit subsection (4).
