9 Fees. E+W+S

The burial authority may demand payment of $[{}^{F1}[{}^{F2}any such]]$ charges or fees, for the burning of human remains in any crematorium provided by them, $[{}^{F1}[{}^{F2}as may be authorised by any table approved by the Local Government Board,]] and such charges or fees, and any other expenses properly incurred in or in connection with the cremation of a deceased person, shall be deemed to be part of the funeral expenses of the deceased.$
