## 9 Fees. **E+W+S**

The burial authority may demand payment of [<sup>F1</sup>[<sup>F2</sup>any such]] charges or fees, for the burning of human remains in any crematorium provided by them, [<sup>F1</sup>[<sup>F2</sup>as may be authorised by any table approved by the Local Government Board,]] and such charges or fees, and any other expenses properly incurred in or in connection with the cremation of a deceased person, shall be deemed to be part of the funeral expenses of the deceased.
