CROWN LANDS ACT 1906

- 1 President of Board of Agriculture to be additional Commissioner of Woods
- 2 Power to effect transfers of the management of foreshore between Commissioners of Woods and Board of Trade
- 3 Power of Board of Trade, &c. to settle disputes as to foreshore
- 4 Power of Commissioners of Woods to pay for certain improvements out of capital
- 5 Abolition of enrolment of assignments, &c. of Crown leases
- 6 Power of Commissioners of Works to convey bridges
- 7 Power to transfer management of Richmond and Kew Greens
- 8 Apportionment of quit and Crown rents in Ireland
- 9 Limitation of time for proceedings for recovery by Crown of quit and other rents
