1 Liability of owner of dog for injury to cattle.

- $F^{1}(1)$
- - (4) Where a dog is proved to have injured cattle [^{F3} or poultry] or chased sheep, it may be dealt with under [^{F4} section two of the ^{M1}Dogs Act, 1871,][^{F4} section 9 of the Control of Dogs (Scotland) Act 2009] as a dangerous dog.
