##### *Miscellaneous*

#### **43 Patent on application of representative of deceased inventor**

- (1) If the person claiming to be inventor of an invention dies without making an application for a patent for the invention, application may be made by, and a patent for the invention granted to, his legal representative.
- (2) Every such application must contain a declaration by the legal representative that he believes him to be the true and first inventor of the invention.
