PART I

GENERAL

5 Enquiries by Local Government Board.

- (1) [F1The Secretary of State] may direct any enquiries to be held by [F1his] inspectors which [F1he] may deem necessary in regard to the exercise of any powers conferred upon [F1him] under this Act . . . F2

- (3) The Secretary of State may order that a local enquiry be held in regard to the exercise of any powers conferred on him under this Act . . . ^{F2}
