MISCELLANEOUS

26 Works below highwater mark not to be carried out without approval of Board of Trade.

Nothing in this Act shall authorise the execution of any works on, over, or under tidal lands below highwater mark of ordinary spring tides except in accordance with such plans and sections, and subject to such restrictions and regulations, as, previous to such works being commenced, have been approved by the Board of Trade in writing . . . ^{F1}
