Juvenile Offenders

57 Punishment of certain grave crimes.

- (3) A person detained pursuant to the directions of the Secretary of State under [^{F2}section [^{F3}205 or 206]of the ^{M1}Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975][^{F4}or section 25 of the Prisons (Scotland) Act 1989]shall, while so detained, be deemed to be in legal custody.
