PART I

ARTICLES OF WAR

Insubordination and similar offences

13 Fighting and quarrelling.

Every person subject to this Act who [^{F1}without reasonable excuse]—

- (a) fights \dots ^{F2} with any other person, whether subject to this Act or not; or
- (b) uses threatening, abusive, insulting or provocative words or behaviour likely to cause a disturbance,

shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or any less punishment authorised by this Act.
