



# Defence Contracts Act 1958

1958 CHAPTER 38 6 and 7 Eliz 2

## 5 Expenses.

There shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament any increase attributable to section one of this Act in the sums required for making payments on behalf of a Government department under section forty-six of the <sup>M1</sup>Patents Act 1949, or under paragraph 1 of the First Schedule to the <sup>M2</sup>Registered Designs Act 1949, and any sums required by a competent authority for making payments under section four of this Act.
