5 Financial provisions.

—There shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament—

- (a) any administrative expenses incurred for the purposes of this Act by the Secretary of State or the Minister; and
- (b) any increase in the sums payable out of moneys so provided, under the ^{M1}Local Government (Financial Provisions) (Scotland) Act, 1954, as amended by the ^{M2}Valuation and Rating (Scotland) Act, 1956, which is attributable to the provisions of this Act.
