V. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE CHEVENING ESTATE AND THE CONTENTS

- 9 For the purposes of Section 29 of the ^{M1}Settled Land Act 1925 the trusts declared by Clause 4 (ii) and [^{F1}Clauses 5 to 6A]hereof shall be deemed to be public trusts and the powers referred to in sub-section (1) of that section shall ([^{F2}after the death of the settlor]) be exercisable in relation to the Chevening Estate by the [^{F3}Board] . . . ^{F4}
