



# Carriage by Air Act 1961

1961 CHAPTER 27 9 and 10 Eliz 2

## 14 Short title, interpretation and repeals.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Carriage by Air Act 1961.
- (2) In this Act the expression “court” includes (in an arbitration allowed by the Convention) and arbitrator.
- (3) On the date on which section one of this Act comes into force the Acts specified in the Second Schedule to this Act shall be repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule:

Provided that, without prejudice to section thirty-eight of the <sup>M1</sup>Interpretation Act 1889 (which relates to the effect of repeals), this subsection shall not affect any rights or liabilities arising out of an occurrence before that date.
