CHAPTER 69

VESTRIES ACT 1818 (REPEALED 1.6.1992)

- [1.] Three days notice to be given of vestries; by publications in the church, and affixing on church door.
- 2 Chairman of the vestry appointed to have a casting vote. Minutes to be entered and signed.
- 3 Manner of voting in vestries.
- 4 Inhabitants coming into a parish since the last rate may vote.
- 5

- 7 Provisions in relation to parishes extended to townships, &c. Manner of giving notice of vestries and meetings in special cases.
- 8 Not to alter time for holding vestries, specially directed; nor to affect vestries held under special Acts, &c.
- 9 Not to extend to London;
- 10 nor to Southwark;
- 11 to extend only to England and Wales.

Changes to legislation:

There are currently no known outstanding effects for the Vestries Act 1818 (repealed 1.6.1992).
