

Dean Forest Act 1819

1819 CHAPTER 86 59 Geo 3

VIII The Gaveller may recover the Gale Rent or Gale Money by Action in a Court of Record.

It shall and may be lawful for the Principal Gaveller for the time being of the said Forest of *Dean*, to sue for and recover any arrears or sums ... ^{F1} at any time hereafter to grow or become due, from any person or persons for and in respect of any such compositions as aforesaid, in any of His Majesty's Courts of Record; and all such actions shall be brought in the name of the Principal Gaveller for the time being of the said Forest of *Dean*; ... ^{F1}
