1822 CHAPTER 33

IX Form of Conviction.

And be it further enacted, That all Justices of the Peace before whom any Person shall be convicted of any Offence against this Act shall and may cause the Conviction to be drawn up in the following Form of Words, or to the like Effect:

^{Chy or County} ^{df} to wit. ^A B. is convicted before me C. D. One of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the said [County, City, Town, Cinque Port, Ancient Town, Corporate Town, Hundred, Rape, Wapentake, Lathe, Riding, Division, or Liberty, as the Case may be] by virtue of an Act made in the Third Year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled [here set forth the Title of the Act, and specify the Offence, and the Time and Place when and where the same was committed, as the Case may be]. Given under my Hand and Seal, the Day and Year aforesaid.
