1825 CHAPTER 120 6 Geo 4

48 As to cases of suspension before the lord ordinary.

The lord ordinary in the outer house, before whom any suspension . . . ^{F1} shall come to be discussed, shall proceed in preparing the cause for judgment after the manner already directed as to causes in the outer house; and the party resisting the suspension shall be required, by way of defence in the outer house, to return answers to the reasons of suspension.
