1830 CHAPTER 37 11 Geo 4 and 1 Will 4

13 Provisions of 9 Geo. 4. extended to inferior judges, &c. in certain cases

The ^{MI}Circuit Courts (Scotland) Act 1828 in so far as it provides for rendering all inferior judges and magistrates more safe in the execution of their duty, shall extend to all acts done by any such judge or magistrate in apprehending any party, or in regard to any criminal cause or proceeding, or to any prosecution for a pecuniary penalty.
