

## Criminal Law (Scotland) Act 1830

1830 CHAPTER 37 11 Geo 4 and 1 Will 4

## 7 Officers may cite jurors and witnesses, without witnesses.

It shall be sufficient for the legal citation of any juror or witness in any [<sup>F1</sup>civil cause or proceeding], that such citation be given by any officer of the law duly authorized, without witnesses; and the oath of such officer in support of the execution shall be held and received as sufficient evidence of such citation when the same shall be questioned in a court of law.
