1911 CHAPTER 27 1 and 2 Geo 5

## <sup>F2</sup>[<sup>F1</sup>5A Attendance at animal fights.

[<sup>F2</sup>A person who, without reasonable excuse, is present when animals are placed together for the purpose of their fighting each other shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.]]
