

# War Memorials (Local Authorities' Powers) Act 1923

# 1923 CHAPTER 18 13 and 14 Geo 5

## U.K.

An Act to enable local authorities under certain circumstances to maintain, repair and protect war memorials vested in them. [18th July 1923]

#### Modifications etc. (not altering text)

C1 Act extended (S.) with modifications by Local Government Act 1948 (c. 26), s. 133(3)

C2 Councils of administrative counties, boroughs (except those in rural districts), urban districts, rural districts and urban parishes outside Greater London and Isles of Scilly together with municipal corporations of boroughs outside Greater London now abolished and councils of metropolitan counties, non-metropolitan counties and districts constituted by Local Government Act 1972 (c. 70), ss. 1, 2, Sch. 1

#### 1 Expenditure in maintenance, &c., of war memorials. U.K.

A local authority may incur reasonable expenditure in the maintenance, repair and protection of any war memorial within their district [<sup>F1</sup>whether vested in them or not.]

## 3 Application. U.K.

The provisions of this Act shall not apply to a war memorial provided or maintained by a local authority in the exercise of any other statutory power.

## 4 Definition. U.K.

In this Act the expression "local authority" means the council of a county, . . .  $^{F3}$ borough . . .  $^{F3}$ district or parish, and the parish meeting of a rural parish with no parish council.
