RULES, FEE ORDERS, REGULATIONS, SHORT TITLE, COMMENCEMENT AND EXTENT.

146 Orders as to remuneration of solicitors.

- (1) The remuneration of solicitors in conveyancing and other non-contentious business under this Act shall from time to time be prescribed and regulated by general orders made by the Committee in England constituted under section two of the Solicitors Remuneration Act, 1881; provided that the Chief Land Registrar shall, for the purposes aforesaid, be an additional member of that committee.
- (2) The provisions of the last-mentioned Act apply to any general order made under this section.
