ADAPTATION OF ENACTMENTS.

Special Adaptations.

The provisions of the Poor Law Act, 1927, with respect to the qualification, election and term of office and retirement of guardians and to the qualification of the chairman of a board of guardians shall, as applied by subsection (4) of section twenty-four of the Local Government Act, 1894, to district councillors and to the chairman of a district council of a rural district, have effect as if for references therein to "a guardian," "guardians," "guardians of a poor law union," and "members of a board of guardians," there were substituted references to a "rural district councillor" or "rural district councillors," as the case may require, as if for references to "board of guardians" there were substituted references to "rural district council," and as if for references to "union" or "poor law union" there were substituted references to "rural district."
