Supplementary Provisions as to Legal Proceedings

102 † Appeals to quarter sessions.

(1) Appeals to [^{F1}the Crown Court] from orders of a court of summary jurisdiction under this Act may be brought in the following cases and by the following persons, that is to say—

- (a) F2
- (c) F3
- (e) in the case of an order requiring the owner of an automatic machine for the sale of tobacco or the person on whose premises such a machine is kept, to take precautions to prevent the machine being extensively used by persons apparently under the age of sixteen years or to remove the machine, by any person aggrieved;
- (f) F4

(2) Nothing in this section shall be construed as affecting the . . . ^{F5} any other right of appeal conferred by this or any other Act.
