

National Maritime Museum Act 1934

1934 CHAPTER 43 24 and 25 Geo 5

5 Staff.

- (1) There shall be a Director of the Museum who shall be appointed [FIby the Board with the approval of the Prime Minister] and shall hold office on such terms and subject to such conditions [FIas the Board may determine subject to such conditions as the Lord President of the Council may impose with the consent of the Treasury], and shall, subject to the control and direction of the Board, be charged with the care of the Museum and of the objects collected there.
- (2) The Board may, F2. . ., appoint such officers and servants as the Board think fit; and there shall be paid to the Director of the Museum and to any officers so appointed such salaries or remuneration [F3 as the Board may determine subject to such conditions as the Lord President of the Council may impose with the consent of the Treasury].
