5 Staff.

- (1) There shall be a Director of the Museum who shall be appointed [^{F1}by the Board with the approval of the Prime Minister] and shall hold office on such terms and subject to such conditions [^{F1}as the Board may determine subject to such conditions as the Lord President of the Council may impose with the consent of the Treasury], and shall, subject to the control and direction of the Board, be charged with the care of the Museum and of the objects collected there.
- (2) The Board may, ^{F2}. . . , appoint such officers and servants as the Board think fit; and there shall be paid to the Director of the Museum and to any officers so appointed such salaries or remuneration [^{F3}as the Board may determine subject to such conditions as the Lord President of the Council may impose with the consent of the Treasury].
