NOTIFICATION OF BIRTHS; MATERNITY AND CHILD WELFARE, AND CHILD LIFE PROTECTION

### *Maternity and child welfare*

**205 Women not to be employed in factories<sup>F1</sup> . . . within four weeks after birth of a child.**

If the occupier of a factory<sup>F1</sup> . . . knowingly allows a woman to be employed therein within four weeks after she has given birth to a child, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F2</sup>level 1 on the standard scale].<sup>F3</sup>...
