  - (c) except where the birth is of an illegitimate child—
    - (i) the date of the parents' marriage [F3 or of their formation of a civil partnership];
    - (ii) [F4where the parents are married,] whether the mother had been married before her marriage to the father of the child;
    - (iii) [F4where the parents are married,] the number of children of the mother by her present husband and by any former husband, and how many of them were born alive or were still-born.
