- (a) the appointment of, and the tenure and vacation of office by, the members of the [F7Generating Board] and any Area Board;
- (b) the quorum, proceedings, meetings and determinations of the [F7Generating Board] and any Area Board;
- (c) the execution of instruments and the mode of entering into contracts by and on behalf of the [F7Generating Board] or any Area Board, and the proof of documents purporting to be executed, issued or signed by the [F7Generating Board] or any Area Board or a member or officer thereof; and
- (d) any other matters supplementary or incidental to the matters aforesaid for which provision appears to the Minister to be necessary or expedient.]
- [F6(8) Subject to the provisions of any regulations made under the last foregoing subsection, the [F7Generating Board] and every Area Board shall have power to regulate their own procedure.]
