## *Wages and Holidays*

### <sup>F24</sup> [<sup>F1</sup>Enforcement of holidays orders.]

[<sup>F3</sup>(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, if an employer fails—

- <sup>F4</sup>(a) .....
- <sup>F4</sup>(b) .....
- (c) to allow to any such worker the holidays fixed by the order; [<sup>F5</sup>or
- <sup>F4</sup>(d) .....]

he shall be liable on summary conviction in respect of each offence to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds <sup>F6</sup> . . .

(3) In any proceedings against a person under this section it shall lie with him to prove that he <sup>F8</sup> . . . has allowed the holidays fixed by the order, <sup>F8</sup> . . .
