

# New Forest Act 1949

### 1949 CHAPTER 69 12 13 and 14 Geo 6

#### 20 Expenses and receipts.

- (1) The expenses of the Minister under this Act shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament, and the receipts of the Minister thereunder in so far as they accrue under section fourteen of this Act shall be paid into the Exchequer, and in so far as they accrue under sections sixteen to eighteen thereof shall be [<sup>F1</sup>treated in the manner specified in section 41 of the Forestry Act 1967].
- (2) The expenses of the Forestry Commissioners under this Act shall be defrayed [<sup>F1</sup>in accordance with section 41 of the Forestry Act 1967].
- (3) Any increase attributable to the provisions of this Act in the sums payable out of moneys provided by Parliament under Part I of the <sup>MI</sup>Local Government Act 1948 shall be defrayed out of moneys so provided.
