- (1) A court of summary jurisdiction in England shall have jurisdiction in proceedings against a person residing in Scotland or Northern Ireland—
 - (a)
 - for an order under section forty-three of the M1National Assistance Act 1948 (which provides for the recovery from spouses or parents of sums in respect of assistance given under that Act).
 - $f^{F6}(c)$ for an order under section 18 of the M2Supplementary Benefits Act 1976 (which provides for the recovery of expenditure on supplementary benefits from persons liable for maintenance).
 - $I^{F7}(d)$ for an order under section 24 of the Social Security Act 1986 (which provides for the recovery of expenditure on income support from such persons);]
- (2) A court in England by which an order has been made under . . . F8 the said section forty-three [F9 or the said section 18][F10 or the said section 24]shall have jurisdiction in proceedings by or against a person residing in Scotland or Northern Ireland for the revocation, revival or variation of that order.
