

# Maintenance Orders Act 1950

1950 CHAPTER 37 14 Geo 6

### PART III

#### GENERAL

#### 28 Interpretation.

(1) In this Act the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them, that is to say—

"certified copy", in relation to an order of any court, means a copy certified by the proper officer of the court to be a true copy of the order or of the official record thereof;

"collecting-officer"  $^{F1}$ ...  $[^{F2}$ ...] in relation to a court of summary jurisdiction in Northern Ireland, means the officer  $[^{F3}$  authorised to act as such for the purposes of Article 85 of the Magistrates' Courts (Northern Ireland) Order 1981.];

"enactment" includes any order, rule or regulation made in pursuance of any Act;

"England" includes Wales;

"prescribed" means, in relation to a court of summary jurisdiction in <sup>F5</sup>... Northern Ireland, prescribed <sup>F6</sup>... by rules made [<sup>F7</sup>under section 23 of the <sup>M1</sup>Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964], <sup>F8</sup>... and in relation to any other court means prescribed by rules of court.

- (2) References in this Act to parts of the United Kingdom are references to England, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- (3) Any reference in this Act to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment, including this Act.
