10 Jurisdiction of court.

- (1) Subject to the provisions of [^{F1}section one hundred and fifteen of the ^{M1}County Courts Act 1959] (which provides for the removal into the High Court of any proceedings commenced in a county court), the jurisdiction of the court under this Act shall be exercised [^{F2}in England and Wales by the county court and in Northern Ireland]by a county court.
