MEETING OF PARLIAMENT WHEN PROROGUED

34 Time for summoning parliament during prorogation.

The date appointed for the meeting of parliament by a proclamation issued under section one of the ^{M1}Meeting of Parliament Act 1797 (which relates to the summoning of parliament when prorogued), may be any day after the date of the proclamation;^{F3}
