3 **†Seal and acts of Minister.**

- (1) [^{F1}The Secretary of State for Education and Science] shall have an official seal which shall be authenticated by the signature of [^{F1}the Secretary of State for Education and Science] or of a secretary to [^{F1}the Department of the Secretary of State] or of any person authorised by [^{F1}the Secretary of State for the Education and Science] to authenticate the seal.
- (2) The seal of [^{F1}the Secretary of State for Education and Science] shall be officially and judicially noticed, and every document purporting to be an instrument made or issued by [^{F1}the Secretary of State for Education and Science] and either to be sealed with the seal of [^{F1}the Secretary of State for Education and Science] authenticated in the manner provided by this section, or to be signed by a secretary to [^{F1}the Department of the Secretary of State] or by any other officer of [^{F1}the Department of the Secretary of State] or by any other officer of [^{F1}the Department of the Secretary of State] or by any legal proceedings be deemed to be so made or issued without further proof, unless the contrary is shown.
- (3) A certificate signed by [^{F1}the Secretary of State for Education and Science] certifying that any instrument purporting to be made or issued by him was so made or issued shall be conclusive evidence of the fact certified.
