PART VII

APPLICATION AND AMENDMENTS OF DEFENCE ACTS, &C.

Power to acquire particular levels only and reversionary interests.

- (1) . . . ^{F1}, the surface of any land may be acquired under the Defence Acts without the minerals or subjacent strata or any part thereof and (subject to the provisions of [F2 section 10(3) of the Coal Industry Act 1994]) the minerals or subjacent strata or any part thereof may be acquired under those Acts without the surface.
- (2) Without prejudice to any power in that behalf exercisable under the Defence Acts apart from this section, where a Minister or any person on behalf of a Minister is in possession of any land under a lease or tenancy . . . ^{FI}, any interest reversionary thereon may be acquired under the Defence Acts.
