

British Settlements Act 1945

1 Amendment of s. 3 of 50 & 51 Vict. c. 54.

Section three of the British Settlements Act 1887 (which empowers His Majesty, by any instrument passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom or by any instructions under His Majesty's Royal Sign Manual referred to in any such instrument as made or to be made as respects any British settlement, to delegate to any three or more persons within the settlement all or any of the powers conferred by that Act on His Majesty in Council) shall have effect as if—

- (a) any reference therein to an instrument passed as aforesaid included a reference to an Order of His Majesty in Council; and
- (b) for the reference therein to any three or more persons within the settlement there were substituted a reference to any specified person or persons or authority.
