8 Notices may be given by the secretary of the commissioners, or other person appointed for that purpose.

All notices by the Inclosure Act, 1845, or by any Act amending the same or referring thereto, or by this Act, directed or authorized to be given by the [^{F1}commissioners] and assistant commissioners respectively may be given by the secretary of the commissioners, or by any person whom the commissioners or any assistant commissioner, in conformity with the power delegated to him by the commissioners, may appoint or authorize for that purpose.
