

Commissioners Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 16 10 and 11 Vict

Access to special Act

111 Penalty on commissioners failing to keep or deposit such copies.

If the commissioners fail to keep or deposit, as herein-before mentioned, any of the said copies of the special Act, they shall forfeit [^{F1}level 2 on the standard scale][^{F2}level 1 on the standard scale] for every such offence, and also five pounds for every day afterwards during which such copy shall be not so kept or deposited.
