Byelaws

84 Byelaws may be enforced by imposition of penalties. U.K.

[^{F1} The undertakers may, by the byelaws so to be made by them, impose such reasonable penalties as they shall think fit, not exceeding [^{F2} level 3 on the standard scale] for each breach of such byelaws ^{F3}]
