



# Harbours, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 27

*Recovery of Damages and Penalties*

**XCII Railways Clauses Consolidation Acts, 1845, as to Damages, &c. to be incorporated with this and the Special Act.**

If the Harbour, Dock, or Pier be in *England* or *Ireland*, the Clauses of the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, with respect to the Recovery of Damages not specially provided for, and Penalties, and to the Determination of any other Matter referred to Justices, shall be incorporated with this and the Special Act; and if the Harbour, Dock, or Pier be in *Scotland*, the Clauses of the Rail-Ways Clauses Consolidation Act (*Scotland*), 1845, with respect to the Recovery of Damages not specially provided for, and to the Determination of any other Matter referred to the Sheriff or to Justices, shall be incorporated with this and the Special Act, and such Clauses shall apply to the Harbour, Dock, or Pier, and to the Undertakers respectively, and shall be construed as if the Word " Undertakers " had been inserted therein instead of the Word " Company. "
