Nuisances

CVI Commissioners to order Costs of Prosecutions to be paid out of the Rates.

The Commissioners may direct any Prosecution for any public Nuisance whatsoever, created, permitted, or suffered within the Limits of the special Act, and may order Proceedings to be taken for the Recovery of any Penalties, and for the Punishment of any Persons offending against the Provisions of this or the special
