Prevention of nuisances

19 Certain provisions of Waterworks Clauses Act 1847, incorporated with this Act.

When any street or road or sewer shall be opened with such consent as aforesaid, the clauses of the [FIM] Water Act 1945] with respect to breaking up streets for the purpose of laying pipes, so far as the same are consistent with this Act and applicable thereto, shall be incorporated with this Act, and shall apply to the company, and to any ground broken by them for making any such sewer or drain as aforesaid to open into any existing sewer.
