



Judicial Factors Act 1849

1849 CHAPTER 51 12 and 13 Vict

10 General nature of accountant's duty;

The accountant shall superintend generally the conduct of all judicial factors [^{F1}[^{F2}, tutors] and curators] coming under the provisions of this Act already appointed or to be hereafter appointed, and shall see that they duly observe all rules and regulations affecting them for the time.
