## **1852 CHAPTER 76**

## Pleadings

## LXIII Time for pleading, where Defendant is within Jurisdiction, to be Eight Days.

In Cases where the Defendant is within the Jurisdiction, the Time for pleading in Bar, unless extended by the Court or a Judge, shall be Eight Days; and a Notice requiring the Defendant to plead thereto in Eight Days, otherwise Judgment, may, whether the Declaration be delivered or filed, be indorsed upon the Declaration, or delivered separately.
