

Inclosure Act 1852

1852 CHAPTER 79 15 and 16 Vict

1 No lands to be inclosed without the previous authority of Parliament.

Notwithstanding the provisions in the MIInclosure Act 1845 it shall not be lawful for the Inclosure Commissioners to give notice of their intention to proceed with the inclosure of any lands without the previous direction of Parliament; and no land shall be inclosed under the said recited Acts and this Act without the previous authority of Parliament in each particular case FI. . .
