1839 CHAPTER 47

XII Summons and Warrants in Criminal Proceedings to be executed by them.

And be it enacted. That after the passing of this Act all Summons and Warrants to be issued in any Criminal Proceeding within the Metropolitan Police District, or by any Magistrate within the said District, shall be served and executed by a Constable of the Metropolitan Police Force, and by none other.
