1858 CHAPTER 56 21 and 22 Vict

## 3 To whom petition to be presented.

Such petition shall be presented to the commissary of the county wherein the deceased died domiciled, and, in the case of persons dying domiciled furth of Scotland, or without any fixed or known domicile, having . . . .<sup>F1</sup> property in Scotland, to the commissary of Edinburgh.
